Student's Right to Cancel

A student may withdraw from the seminary at any time by completing the necessary paperwork through the Registrar's office. A student cannot assume that a class is dropped simply by not attending.

Students who withdraw before the start of a term will be refunded any tuition paid. However, registration fees and application fees are non-refundable.

Students who withdraw after the start of a term but before 50% of a course is completed will receive refunds based on the following:

When a student drops a class after the first day of the term, the student must pay for contact hours attended (or even those not attended if the student fails to notify the Registrar's office). The student will receive a refund or adjustment to his/her account. At the current rates, tuition is \$24 per contact hour. Fees are nonrefundable.

For Internet courses, the professor will verify the last date of attendance to calculate contact hours in the course in order to arrive at the amount of refund or adjustment.

At Central Baptist Theological Seminary, 1 credit is the equivalent of 15 contact hours.

Students who withdraw after the start of a term but after 50% of a course is completed will not receive any refund.
